Get a jumpstart on your BSHM

While pursuing an Associate Degree in an Allied Health program with one of our alliance community colleges you can get a jumpstart on your Bachelor of Science in Health Management (BSHM) degree at the University of Phoenix. Through our Concurrent Enrollment Program (CEP) you can complete the following four upper division courses while finishing your Associate Degree at your college.

- **HCS/321** – Business Communication for Health Care Managers
- **HCS/325** – Health Care Management
- **HCS/370** – Organizational Behavior
- **HCS/335** – Health Care Ethics and Social Responsibility

You will also be eligible for our Tuition Guarantee Program which will freeze your tuition at \$350 per credit hour while you complete your BSHM program.

How it works

You enroll in the CEP classes at University of Phoenix between semesters at your community college. You may begin after the first, second, or third semester, and depending upon when you start, can complete up to 4 upper division courses.

You will be enrolled in courses with other associate degree completers, providing a built-in support system. And upon completion, your associate degree will transfer into the University of Phoenix BSHM program under our current articulation agreement with your community college.

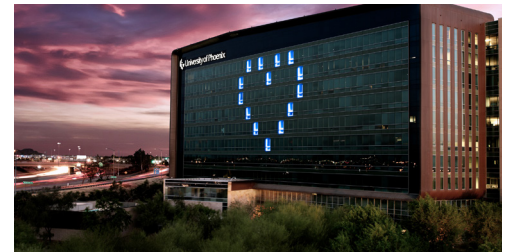
